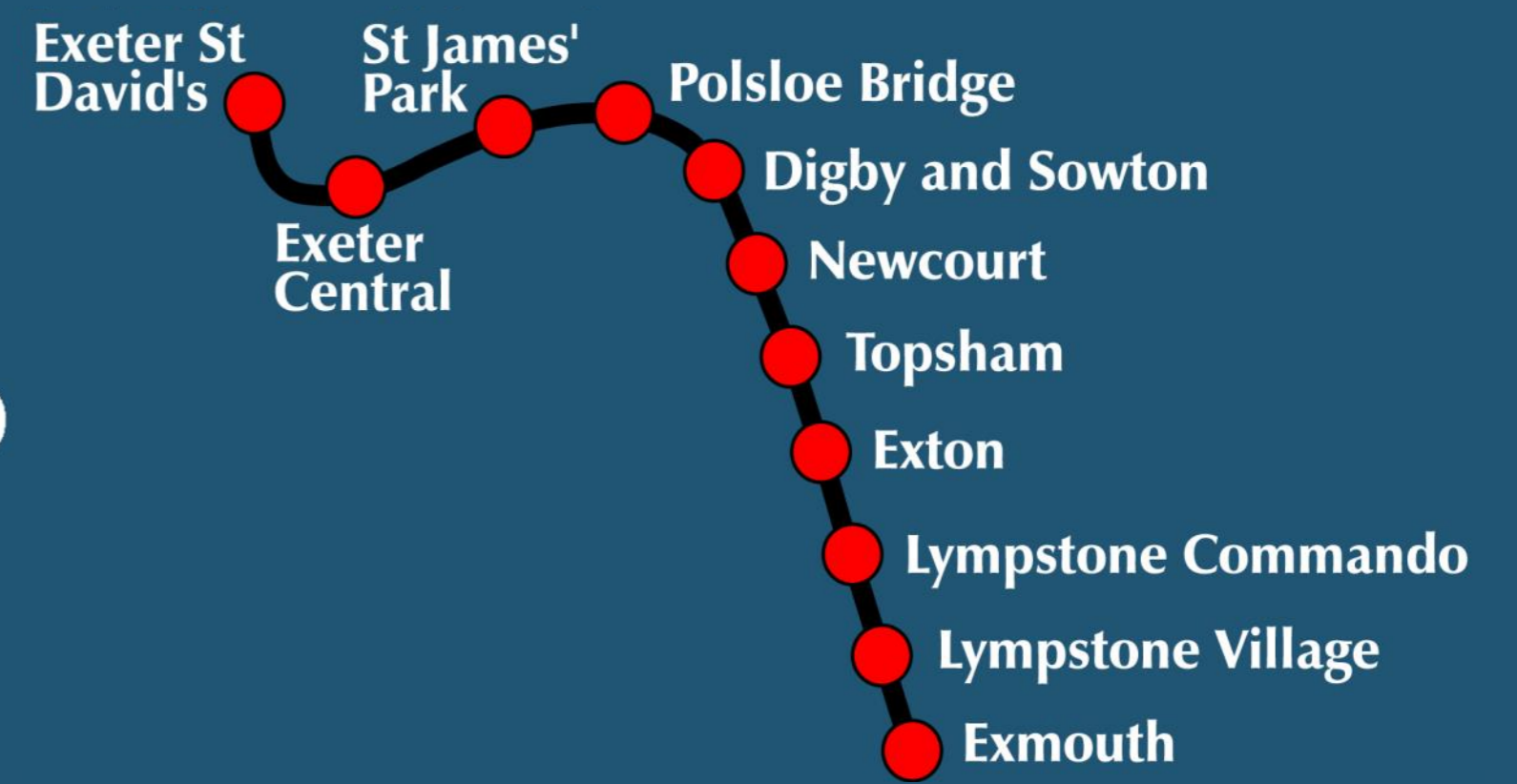




# AVOCET LINE RAIL USERS GROUP



## DISCOUNTS FOR DINERS TRAVELLING ON THE AVOCET LINE

Gastropubs along the Avocet Line from Exeter to Exmouth are offering discounts to diners who travel there by train. Rail passengers can get 10% off their food bill at selected pubs when they show the train ticket for their journey. The discounts will run until the end of March, excluding Valentine's weekend, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> February, and Easter weekend 25<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> March. All are close to stations on the Avocet Line.. Participating pubs are:
